Q. Where can I go Paragliding?

Most day trips are made outside of Pokhara City as the surrounding area offers some of the best flight. Paragliding operators will also take longer tours on request. These trips are often personalized and take you to parts of Nepal where conditions allow safe and fun flights.

Q. How long does a Paragliding take?

A typical day trip takes 35 to 40 minutes. However, you should reserve at least two hours as it will take some time to reach the site, check equipment, briefing and adjust.

Q. How safe is Pokhara Paragliding?

Paragliders take safety very seriously. Business trips that carry non-tandem travelers remain within the security limits, and the equipment used is never compromised. It is for the benefit of you and your pilots if you fly and no pilot will endanger their safety, and certainly not yours. Most daily flights depart from Sarangkot Hill. All the pilots fly frequently, and flights land from a controlled take-off area on a grassy hill and land near the lake.

Q. When is a good season for Paragliding in Nepal?

You can do Paragliding all year round, except for the short rainy season. Before the summer and after the monsoon are the best seasons for warm flights.

Q. Do I need previous training for Paragliding in Nepal?

No, you do not need any previous knowledge. If it is not a licensed paraglider, you will be carried on a tandem glider, which means that a pilot will accompany you and fly the glider. All you have to relax sitting back.
