Kathmandu has many world heritage sites. They are Pashupatinath Temple, Swayambhunath Stupa, Boudhanath Stupa, and Kathmandu Durbar Square. The name of the city Kathmandu also comes from the temple that is located inside Kathmandu Durbar Square, Kasthamandap Temple. An essential thing in Kathmandu is to see the holy Hindu temple, Pashupatinath, and the largest Buddhist stupa. With Pashupatinath, you can understand crucial Hinduism and learn how Hindus cremated the corpse of it. Boudhanath is an ancient stupa that is believed to contain the Kashyap Buddha's relics based on the stupa's foundation.

You will fly or drive to Pokhara with a breathtaking view of the Himalayan Mountains on your Kathmandu Pokhara tour. You can also take the tourist bus, but it is a very long trip, and you will again lose your two days. When you land in Pokhara, the Annapurna Himalayas are perfectly visible from the airport and from

anywhere. You will see Annapurna II, Mt. Fishtail, Mt. Dhaulagiri, and many more peaks. There are many places to visit in Pokhara, such as Saragkot, World Peace Stupa, International Mountain Museums, Davis Falls, Phewa Lake, and many more. The peaceful and beautiful surroundings of Pokhara allow you to enjoy your holidays in its excellent tourist sites.

## **Detail Itinerary**

### **Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu, Nepal.**

Upon arrival at Kathmandu International Airport, our representative will greet you with a Nepalese flower garland and accompany you to your hotel in Kathmandu. Evening time is a break to explore the Thamel area, the leading center for tourists. You will have dinner in one of the best Nepalese restaurants with its cultural/traditional dance show. Night at the Hotel Kathmandu.

### **Day 02: Early Morning Mountain Flight and sightseeing in Kathmandu**

**Early morning, Mountain Flight:** You will meet our staff early in the morning at the hotel lobby. Depart from your hotel to the Kathmandu Domestic Airport terminal for a one-hour scenic flight over the mountain. This flight is an impressive experience with a multitude of snow-covered mountain panoramas. You can see the mountain ranges from this scenic flight. The Mountain ranges Extend from Ganesh Himal, Langtang, and Jugal Himal to Gaurishankar, Melun Tse, and Dorji Lakpa in the middle that extends up to Mount Everest. You can also see Mt Makalu in the east of Everest. On this flight, you will experience four of the highest peaks in the world. After an overwhelming flight overlooking the mountains, return to the hotel for breakfast.

After having breakfast, You will visit Kathmandu Durbar Square - it is in the heart of Kathmandu with various temples. Monuments, palaces of the ancient king (Durbar) of the modern king, and Kumari Ghar - the home of the living God in Nepal, the most popular, must be seen in Nepal. One should be surprised to see various impressive temples and fascinating old stories from the palaces.

**Swoyambhu Temple:** It is also called the Monkey Temple because you can get large numbers of monkeys. It is very nice to see how different monkeys eat and live in this region with their newborns and small babies. This Buddhist shrine also has excellent historical influence. It is believed that in ancient times Kathmandu was a pond with a mixture of mud and snakes, and from there, a lotus with light arises, and the person conserves it by erecting the sanctuary on it. From that moment on, it is called Swoyambhu, a self-risen temple. You have come to this place; It is believed that all of their sins were washed away. You will feel some peace of mind when you see these wonders from the Buddhist shrine.

### **Boudhanath Stupa:**

It is one of the largest Buddhist shrines in ancient Nepal. This sector influences the majority of the Tibetan population. We can see around 100 different Tibetan monasteries in this region. It is believed that if we pray our wish in front of this shrine, we will be granted. Moreover, some myths say that this is the center of the earth to feel energy and peace of mind when we arrive in this pure and holy sanctuary.

**Pashupatinath Temple:** It is located near the Boudhanath Stupa, although this temple is derived from Hinduism. So anyone who has come to this place feels reassured. Shiva Linga has symbolized himself as the energy and life that inhabit this earth. Therefore we worship the power of the Godhead and the ability to bring about, spread, or live the work of this earth. The uniqueness is seen as a funeral, which has excellent value in Hinduism and is a mystic for the person from another religion. After death, his body is buried. Still, in cremation, we close the corpse's Fire, and we will just let his ashes dissolve in the nearby pure, holy river - Ganga, since Ganga is believed to have the power to wash away all of man's sins in this world. After seeing these prized important landmarks in Kathmandu, we will take you to your hotel. Night in Kathmandu.

### **Kathmandu Durbar Square:**

Kathmandu Durbar Square is the historic landmark of the Kathmandu Valley. Here you will learn how Kathmandu and all of Nepal were ruled. After the unification of

all of Nepal, it was the place Nepal left for a long time before the royal palace of NarayanHiti was built. The living goddess Kumari is the main attraction in Kathmandu Durbar Square.

### **Day 03: Travel or flight to Pokhara**

After breakfast, we will be driven to Pokhara in a comfortable private vehicle, and it will take about 5-6 hours with a panoramic view along the way. ## Essential

### Do

Dress modestly so that your figure is not overly emphasized. It would be best to cover the chest and shoulders, and skirts and pants should go below the knee.

If you express criticism or raise a problem, please contact the person concerned directly. Make sure you don't focus on others.

Try to admire the beauty of Nepalese culture and ask questions. There are many incredible and unknown facets of culture that Nepalese are happy to pass on to foreigners.

Realize the diversity of the Nepalese population and landscape. Contrary to the stereotype that Nepalese people are mountain people, most Nepalese live in low valleys and plains where the climate is sweltering.

### **do not**

Drawing parallels between Nepal and India can offend your Nepalese counterpart. Avoid referring to them as Indian or commenting on a similar accent and appearance.

Do not tell jokes that are sexually stimulating.

Oaths are rarely taken in Nepal and should be avoided around their Nepalese counterpart.

Avoid speaking out in public with others or showing any signs of anger. People don't like public confrontations very much and are quick to avoid those who express negative emotions.

Don't compliment a baby by saying they look healthy or fat. There is a belief that this will bring you sickness.

Avoid criticizing social issues in Nepal unless you have something useful to say. Most Nepalese are aware of their country's shortcomings and government (e.g., poverty, corruption, gender inequality, social inequality). Critics who do not offer solutions are unlikely to be honored and can become quite defensive if the discussion is not well articulated.



Avoid criticizing the Nepal Royal Family unless you have a long term relationship with a Nepalese person.

Calling a Nepalese person "poor" can be offensive. In general, while their country is in a difficult situation, they are very hardworking and avoid asking for help when they can help you.

To be labeled "dishonest" is a potent offense in Nepal, as honesty is a fundamental virtue.

### **How to go to Pokhara from Kathmandu?**

Flight Time (30 minutes)

Flying is the fastest and most convenient way to travel between Kathmandu and Pokhara and is highly recommended if you are short on time. Many flights depart daily from the domestic terminal at Tribhuvan Airport and only take around 30 minutes.

### **How long does it take to get to Pokhara from Kathmandu?**

Yes, the driving route between Kathmandu and Pokhara is almost 210 km. The drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara takes about 5 hours by car and 6 to 7 hours by tourist bus.
