Muktinath, another famous temple, is a pilgrimage site for Hindus and Buddhists. The temple is located at an altitude of 3,710 meters at the foot of Thorong La, a mountain pass in the Mustang district of Nepal. You will also visit Manakamana Temple and other famous Hindu shrines in Nepal. Hinduism is deeply rooted in the psyche of most Nepalese.

Itinerary details

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu

Today you will land at Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu, where our representative will be waiting for you with your name card. He will take you to a hotel. In the afternoon there will be a short briefing about the tour. We will take you to a typical Nepalese restaurant for a welcome dinner. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 02: Visit the most important Hindu pilgrimage sites inside Kathmandu valley

Today you will visit the most important Hindu pilgrimage sites in the Kathmandu Valley. The most important places you will see are Pashupatinath, Budanilkantha, and Boudhanath. In addition, you will visit Kathmandu Durbar Square in Kathmandu, Durbar Square in Patan, and other important tourist destinations. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 03: Drive to Pokhara and detour to Manakamana Temple - 6/7 hours drive.

Early morning you will drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara. On the way to Pokhara, you will make a detour to Manakamana Temple. From Kurintar, you will take the cable car to Manakamana Temple. You will descend to Kurintar before continuing to Pokhara. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 04: Flight to Jomsom, drive to Muktinath, and return to Jomsom.

From Pokhara, you will take a flight to Jomsom in the morning. After freshening up, you will drive from Jomsom to Muktinath Temple. Although Muktinath is

primarily a Hindu temple, Buddhists also revered it. Here, gigantic mountains like Dhaulagiri and Nilgiri echo on the horizon. We return to Jomsom, where we will spend the night.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 05: Return flight to Pokhara and visit some Hindu temples in Pokhara

After breakfast, you will fly from Jomsom back to Pokhara. It will be a scenic flight over green hills, rivers, and mountain settlements. Upon your arrival in Pokhara city, we will transfer you to your hotel. After freshening up, you will visit famous Hindu temples like Bindabashini and Tal Barahi in Pokhara. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 06: Drive from Pokhara to Janakpur - 7/8 hours drive

Today you will drive from Pokhara on flat terrain to Janakpur. On the way, you will enjoy the green vegetation and grain fields. You will pass through some important towns like Chitwan and Hetauda before reaching Janakpur. Overnight stay in Janakpur.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 07: Exploring Janaki temple and other Hindu shrines

Janakpur is a center of Hindu religious and cultural tourism. You are exploring the Janaki Temple, the Ram Temple, the Ram-Sita-Bibaha Temple (where the wedding of Ram and Sita took place), and the surrounding sacred lakes will give you an insight into the Ramayan, a Hindu epic. Today's excursion will also give you an insight into the famous Mithila culture. Overnight stay in Janakpur.

Day 08: Drive from Janakpur to Kathmandu - 6/7 hours

Muktinath is a sacred place highly revered by both Hindus and Buddhists. This pilgrimage site is located in the Mustang district at an altitude of 3,710 meters above sea level. It is famous for the Shalagram pilgrimage. Shaligram is a sacred stone that is considered pagan in Hinduism.

How many Hindu temples are there in Nepal?

There are 492 temples, 15 Shivalayas (shrines of Lord Shiva), and 12 Jyotirlinga (phallic shrines) to discover. On the elevated platform on the Bagmati River, there is also a cremation ground where the last rites of the Hindus are performed.

Which god is worshipped in Nepal?

Shiva is widely regarded as the patron deity of Nepal. Nepal is home to the world-famous Pashupatinath Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site where Hindus from around the world make pilgrimages.
